My interdisciplinary research program uses both qualitative and quantitative approaches and cuts across diverse disciplines including behavioral, historical, infectious and social epidemiology; medical anthropology; social psychology; and sociology. Overall, I am interested in how socio-cultural features of society contribute to population health and wellbeing, including innovative ways to improve the health of marginalized populations such as gender and sexual minorities, substance users, sex workers, and migrant populations in the Global South. My current funded studies include HIV/AIDS prevention among MSM, substance use among adolescents and young adults, research ethics, and the epidemiology and prevention of school-based bullying of gender and sexual minorities. Finally, my research studies value the partnerships of community-based and grass-roots organizations, as well as community advisory boards, when engaging in field research.
